Nearly three years ago, considering increased commercial development, the location of CSX's intermodal operations (contiguous to the current shelter property), and the population growth of Franklin County, CVAS officials decided to build a new, modern animal shelter on a much more suitable site that would meet the growing, future needs of the community.

Haldeman and Hock have a soft spot for animals and have personally adopted dogs from animal shelters. They highly recommend that people 'adopt,' not 'buy,' their family pets. They also encourage community members to volunteer their time at the shelter or consider being a foster parent to one of the many homeless animals.

The shelter is always accepting donations at the current location at 2325 Country Road, Chambersburg. Items they accept are: Dogs-food with no dyes, treats, toys, puppy food, instant rice, lamb or veal food, leashes; Cats-food with no dyes, treats, toys, feline pine cat litter, catnip and kitten food; Other-paper towels, toilet paper, tissues, window cleaner, brillo pads, 55 gallon trash bags, blankets, and towels.
